Battery placement

For the LEDs that work on two CR2032 batteries:

First, insert two CR2032 batteries into the battery holder as shown in the picture (one facing up, one facing down). Once done, switch the on/off switch on the battery holder to the ON position, and your LED kit should be working.



For the LEDs that work on two AA batteries, simply place them according to the battery holder instructions (+ and -).

Remote controlled set

The following information applies only if you purchased a **remote-controlled LED kit**.

Because remote-controlled kits continuously search for a signal, they **will drain the battery even when not in use**. For this reason, it is recommended to switch the kit **OFF** when you are not using the LEDs for a while.

You can do this by sliding the **on/off switch** on the battery holder to **OFF**.

Re-programming the remote

In rare cases, the remote controller may lose its connection with the LED kit. If this happens, you can easily reprogram it by following the steps below:

1. Locate the small PCB with four wires (black, red, blue, and white). On this board, you'll find a **small round push button**.
2. With the kit powered on, **press the small button 8 times**. The blue light will blink a few times to indicate a reset.
3. Press the small button **once**, then wait for the blue light to turn on. When it lights up, press the **A button** on the remote. The blue light will blink briefly to confirm the pairing.
4. Press the small button **twice**, then wait again for the blue light to turn on. When it does, press the **B button** on the remote. The blue light will blink again to confirm the programming is complete.

Cutting the flexible LED: Cosplay Lighting

The following information applies only if you purchased the **Flexible LED: Cosplay Lighting**.

These LED strips can be cut down to any desired length. Before cutting the LED strip with scissors, it is **VERY IMPORTANT** to first remove the batteries from the holder to ensure there is no power. Cutting the LED strips while they are powered on can short-circuit the LEDs and damage them.
